Cuckfield CC playing conditions - 2021

Following the guidance from the Government and the ECB, the following measures will be in place for all cricket matches at Cuckfield Cricket Club (CCC) for the 2021 season unless government and ECB guidance changes:

If you or any member of your family display symptoms of Covid-19, please stay at home and advise CCC (cricket@cuckfieldcc.co.uk).

Player requirements:

- All players will be encouraged to arrive at the ground in their whites as all changing facilities will not be available under current guidelines.
- All players will sanitise their hands upon arrival and regularly throughout the match. When fielding, players must use hand sanitiser during the 'hygiene breaks' (every 6 overs or 20 minutes, whichever is sooner).
- All players will bring their own food/drink with them. Refilling of water bottles is available from the tap by the scoreboard on the main ground. Water bottles or other refreshment containers should not be shared.
- All players will use their own playing kit where possible. If kit is to be shared between players, it must be sanitised between uses.
- Hand sanitiser is available, but players are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitiser for personal use.

Playing conditions:

- All playing conditions will be in line with ECB recommendations ([ECB guidance 12th April 2021](#)).
- Players to maintain social distancing throughout the match (<https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/how-to-stop-the-spread-of-coronavirus-covid-19/how-to-stop-the-spread-of-coronavirus-covid-19>).
- Hand sanitiser will be available throughout the match and must be used by all players during 'hygiene breaks'.
- Each team will have a designated area where they can keep their kit bags and personal items. All personal items are the responsibility of the individual and CCC takes no responsibility for these.
- Captains are responsible for all players. Captains will ensure that all provisions within this guidance are met.

Spectators:

- **Spectators are not currently allowed.**
- A parent, suitable adult or carer may attend to supervise an U18 player/player with a disability.
- Club officials/volunteers may be present to organise on and off-field activities.
- Non-players at the ground must refrain from all contact with the ball e.g. returning it to the field of play.
- Anyone attending a match in a supervisory capacity is required to register their attendance at the ground using the NHS COVID-19 App. Contact details for anyone unable to use the app will be taken by the club for track and trace purposes.
