THE SPIRIT OF CRICKET

Preamble to the Laws



Cricket is a game that owes much of its unique appeal to the fact that it should be played not only within its Laws but also within the Spirit of the Game. Any action which is seen to abuse this spirit causes injury to the game itself. The major responsibility for ensuring the spirit of fair play rests with the captains.

1. There are two Laws which place responsibility for the team's conduct firmly on the captain.

Responsibility of captains

The captains are responsible at all times for ensuring that play is conducted within the Spirit of the Game as well as within the Laws.

Player's conduct

In the event of a player failing to comply with instructions by an umpire, or criticising by word or action the decision of an umpire, or showing dissent, or generally behaving in a manner which might bring the game into disrepute, the umpire concerned shall in the first place report the matter to the other umpire and to the player's captain, and instruct the latter to take action.

2. Fair and unfair play

According to the Laws the umpires are the sole judges of fair and unfair play.

The umpires may intervene at any time and it is the responsibility of the captain to take action where required.

3. The umpires are authorised to intervene in cases of:

- Time wasting
- Damaging the pitch
- Dangerous or unfair bowling
- Tampering with the ball
- Any other action that they consider to be unfair

4. The Spirit of the Game involves RESPECT for:

- Your opponents
- Your own captain
- The roles of the umpires
- The game's traditional values

5. It is against the Spirit of the Game:

- To dispute an umpire's decision by word, action or gesture
- To direct abusive language towards an opponent or umpire
- To indulge in cheating or any sharp practice, for instance:
 - (a) to appeal knowing that the batsman is not out
 - (b) to advance towards an umpire in an aggressive manner when appealing
 - (c) to seek to distract an opponent either verbally or by harassment with persistent clapping or unnecessary noise under the guise of enthusiasm and motivation of one's own side

6. Violence

There is no place for any act of violence on the field of play.

7. Players

Captains and umpires together set the tone for the conduct of a cricket match. Every player is expected to make an important contribution towards this.

LEAGUE REGULATIONS 2013

1. All players must be members of their parent club, as this is an absolute requirement for insurance purposes.
2. Players cannot play IDENTILAM COLTS LEAGUE CRICKET for more than one club during the current season. However, if a club does not have a team entered at a particular age group, then a player will be eligible to join another club, at this age group. In the U12 league Horsham Girls have entered and as a special case agreed by the full Committee girls who play for Horsham can play for another Club in the Identilam league but only one other in the age group for which they qualify under the age rules. The regulation may be overridden by the Management Committee.
3. Registration of Players. All clubs must register their players and have documentary proof of their ages. Registration must be completed at least 24 hours before a player takes part in a match. The registration information can be sent by email or text (which would have the date and time stamp necessary) to the Membership Secretary. As the Membership Secretary is new then for this season we require 48 hours notice prior to a player participating in a match; this Rule will be discussed again at the AGM.
4. Contravention of regulations 1, 2 and 3 will result in the deduction of all points from the offending club in that match. The game will be awarded to the innocent club, who will be awarded winning points. The game will not be replayed.
5. Amendments to the published fixture list are permitted (although not desirable) if agreed with the opposition and advised to the Fixture Secretary, Web Master and the Age Group Recorder by 19th April 2013.
6. After the 19th April only bad weather can be the reason for postponing a game. Every effort must be made to play on the specified date. In the event of a game not being played or if abandoned through adverse weather conditions, the Home Team must take the initiative and agree a new date with the opposition. A minimum of two alternative dates for the re-scheduled match shall be offered. After a minimum of two cancellations or where Clubs cannot agree to re-schedule, 2 POINTS shall be awarded to each club in the Under 9 & 10 age groups or 6 POINTS each in all other age groups. In such circumstances, the Home team shall remain responsible for entering the result, 'Cancelled' in this case, which will automatically award the appropriate points.
Please also refer to the RESULTS ENTRY PROCEDURE which explains the need to inform the various League Officers of postponed or abandoned matches.
7. Where a club has been unable to complete more than 50% of their scheduled matches the points awarded in the matches actually played will be ignored for the purposes of preparing league tables.
8. Any team/club that fails to report a result or postponement/cancellation by Midnight on the day following the game will be deducted 3 POINTS. In the Under 9 and 10 leagues this will be 1 POINT per club.
9. Every effort must be made for the players to be correctly dressed, i.e. white shirts, grey or white trousers, white boots or training shoes.
10. It should be noted that some clubs play on artificial wickets. Players should therefore take the relevant footwear, for both grass and artificial, to all matches and we recommend that the AWAY manager contact the HOME manager to determine the correct footwear required.
11. In the event of any occurrence not provided for in the Rules or Regulations the League Management Committee will decide the matter. This will apply to all competitions under the jurisdiction of the IDENTILAM League.

N.B. The League Management Committee shall consist of the Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary and Fixture Secretary. If any dispute involves their parent club(s), then other officials will be appointed.

12. Six legitimate balls must be bowled in the final over of all games at ALL age groups.

13. It is the responsibility of the AWAY Club to provide the match ball.

14. RESULTS ENTRY PROCEDURE

The following procedure for entering the Results of all matches and for revising the dates of Fixtures shall be strictly adhered to:

- The HOME team shall enter the full result by midnight of the day following the match day. The Age Group Recorder will be checking to see if the result is entered.
- The Opposition shall review the result and scorecard, correcting any names ONLY. If there is any disagreement with score data entered it should be discussed with the HOME team manager and agreement reached. He then ticks the 'confirmed result' box against the result in his Admin section.
- The Age Group Recorder will monitor, via the fixtures list, that the expected results have been entered and confirmed by the opposition, at which point he will 'lock' the result on the League site. It cannot then be altered.
- If a match is not played for an approved reason, e.g. due to weather, by midnight of the day following the scheduled fixture, the home team shall send an e-mail advising of the non-played match and if available, the date of the revised fixture, as agreed with the opposition, to: The Age Group Recorder; The Fixture Secretary; The League Webmaster, The League Secretary and the Opposition Manager.

NO 'CANCELLED' or 'ABANDONED' RESULT IS TO BE ENTERED ON THE WEB SYSTEM, the Result shall be left blank























































When the revised Fixture date, agreed with the opposition, is available, an e-mail shall be sent by the home team to: The Age Group Recorder; The Fixture Secretary; The League Webmaster, The League Secretary and the Opposition Manager confirming the new date which shall be changed by the HOME club on their club web site; the revised date will automatically be reflected on the League and opposition web sites.

The whole procedure will be monitored by the Age Group Recorders and Webmaster.

LAWS FOR THE 2012 SEASON

UNDER 9's

1. Boys must be under 9 on 1st September 2012. Girls must be under 11 on 1st September 2012.
2. Games should be played on weekday evenings at 6.00 pm but may be started earlier by prior agreement.
3. Each team shall comprise 8 players.
4. The length of the pitch shall be 16 yards.
5. Kwik Cricket kit will be used at all times. This means that the orange windball and blue bats are to be used. No protective gear is necessary.
6. 16 overs per side should be bowled. By prior agreement a match may be shortened to 12 overs per side.
7. The batting side shall be divided into 4 pairs, each batting for 4 overs (or 3 overs if the game is reduced to 12 overs per side).
8. No player may bowl more than 4 overs (or 3 overs in a 12 over game).
9. Each team will commence batting with 200 runs.
10. Every time a wicket falls 5 runs are deducted from the team score.
11. When a batsman is dismissed he/she should immediately change ends with the non-striker (on all but the last ball of the over or after a run-out).
12. Wides and no-balls to count as 1 run, there being a maximum of 8 balls bowled in each over except the last over of an innings which must contain 6 legitimate balls.
13. The winning team shall be the side scoring the highest number of runs after deductions for the fall of wickets.
14. Points awarded: 4 for a win, 2 each for a tie or for an abandoned match that cannot be replayed and 1 for a loss. In the event that two or more sides are tied on points net run difference will decide their respective league positions.
15. Each club must nominate an umpire who will stand for the whole match.
16. The Laws of Cricket apply unless amended by these rules. Particular note must be made of Rule 17 below:
 - a) in the interests of consistency and safety, the high ball / beamer must be interpreted in accordance with Law 42.
 - b) any ball having pitched and passing over the batsman's shoulder, standing in his normal batting stance, will be called and signalled NO BALL. Umpires are instructed to operate the warning system, explaining to the offender immediately.
 - c) in the interests of safety, no player shall field within 10 yards of the batsman - in front of the wicket and behind the wicket on the leg side only.
 - d) a ball that bounces MORE THAN TWICE shall be called NO BALL.
17. Substitute fielders will only be allowed in the event of injury to a player already participating in the game. A substitute may also act as non-striker whilst their team is batting. In such circumstances the "live" batsman shall receive strike continuously.
18. For Rules concerning the postponement of matches and awarding of points in the event that a game cannot be played within the season see League Regulations 2013 on page 5.
19. For Rules concerning penalties for the non-reporting of results in a timely fashion - see League Regulations 2013 on page 5.
20. Both teams and their supporters MUST abide by the *MCC Spirit of Cricket* at ALL TIMES.

LAWS FOR THE 2012 SEASON

UNDER 10's

1. Boys must be under 10 on 1st September 2012. Girls must be under 12 on 1st September 2012.
2. Games should be played on Saturday mornings at 9.30 am but may be arranged mid-week if necessary, or started earlier by prior agreement.
3. Each team shall comprise 10 players.
4. The length of the pitch shall be 19 yards.
5. A new small ball (4 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz) must be used. The AWAY team shall provide the match ball. By agreement prior to the start of the match a new ball may be used for each innings.
6. 20 overs per side should be bowled. By prior agreement a match may be shortened to 15 overs per side.
7. The batting side shall be divided into 5 pairs, each batting for 4 overs (or 3 overs if the game is reduced to 15 overs per side).
8. No player may bowl more than 4 overs (or 3 overs in a 15 over game).
9. Each team will commence batting with 200 runs.
10. Every time a wicket falls 5 runs are deducted from the team score.
11. When a batsman is dismissed he/she should immediately change ends with the non-striker (on all but the last ball of the over or after a run-out).
12. Wides and no-balls to count as 1 run, there being a maximum of 8 balls bowled in each over except the last over of an innings which must contain 6 legitimate balls.
13. The winning team shall be the side scoring the highest number of runs after deductions for the fall of wickets.
14. Points awarded: 4 for a win, 2 each for a tie or for an abandoned match that cannot be replayed and 1 for a loss. In the event that two or more sides are tied on points net run difference will decide their respective league positions.
15. *In the knockout stages of a competition the lower number of wickets lost will decide the winners in the event of a tied match. If the number of wickets lost is equal then a count back will take place as at ten overs with the side having scored the most runs being declared the winner.*
16. Each club must nominate an umpire who will stand for the whole match.
17. The Laws of Cricket apply unless amended by these rules. Particular note must be made of Rule 17 below:
 - a) in the interests of consistency and safety, the high ball / beamer must be interpreted in accordance with Law 42.
 - b) any ball having pitched and passing over the batsman's shoulder, standing in his normal batting stance, will be called and signalled NO BALL. Umpires are instructed to operate the warning system, explaining to the offender immediately.
 - c) in the interests of safety, no player shall field within 10 yards of the batsman - in front of the wicket and behind the wicket on the leg side only.
 - d) a ball that bounces MORE THAN TWICE shall be called NO BALL.
18. Substitute fielders will only be allowed in the event of injury to a player already participating in the game. A substitute may also act as non-striker whilst their team is batting. In such circumstances the "live" batsman shall receive strike continuously.

LAWS FOR THE 2012 SEASON

UNDER 11's

1. Boys must be under 11 on 1st September 2012. Girls must be under 13 on 1st September 2012.
2. Games should be played on weekday evenings at 6.00 pm but may be started earlier by prior agreement.
3. The side scoring the most runs will be the Winner.
4. 20 overs per side should be bowled.
 - a) By agreement prior to the match, a match may be shortened to 15 overs per side.
 - b) A side batting second must complete at least 10 overs to ensure a result on a faster scoring rate if the match is stopped due to bad weather.
5. No bowler can bowl more than 4 overs.
6. Batsmen must retire at 25, but may return if the rest of the side is dismissed, but only if a full side (10 or 11 players) is present. If a club fields 9 players or less batsmen who are not out 25 and retired, will not be allowed to bat again.
7. Points awarded: - 20 for a win 10 each for a tie
8. Bonus points (Losing side only): 1 for every 20 runs (Max 100 runs)
1 for every 2 wickets
9. A side obtaining maximum batting points can declare and any of their unused batting overs can be allocated to their allocated bowling overs to help them achieve additional bowling points or a win.
